

Data protection information

Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences collects and processes personal data in order to carry out the application and selection process for the Deutschlandstipendium: Surname, first name, address, matriculation number, study details, bank account details, responsible tax office and tax ID. It also asks for information on previous studies, vocational training, internships and practical work experience, special achievements, commitment and life situation.

In the application and selection process, value judgments (studies, school and job references, etc.) as well as additional data generated during the granting and administration process are also collected and processed.

The collection of personal data for application and selection as well as for granting and administration is based on the consent of the data subjects in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a. EU GDPR. [...] For the granting and administration of scholarships, processing [also] takes place in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. e EU GDPR. Data is processed for administration and payment.

The stored data is protected in accordance with the latest technical standards. The persons who process the applications and the members of the selection committee are obliged to maintain confidentiality. If technical service providers are given access to personal data, this is done on the basis of a contract in accordance with Art. 28 GDPR.

After the selection process has been completed, the personal data of the selected applicants for a scholarship and 20 subsequent applicants who could potentially receive a scholarship will be stored. The personal data of applications that are not selected will be deleted 15 months after the end of the application phase - unless statutory provisions require otherwise or storage/retention is necessary for the purpose of providing evidence.

If a scholarship is awarded, your data will be stored for ten years after the end of the funding period. After this period has expired, your personal data will be deleted and anonymized data on the scholarship will be stored and processed for statistical purposes, unless documentation or archiving obligations require your personal data to be stored for longer.

Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences uses the anonymized application data to compile statistics for the further development of the Deutschlandstipendium.

Consent can be revoked at any time in writing or electronically without giving reasons to the data controller. If you withdraw your consent, your application may no longer be considered in the current procedure.

Rights:

You can assert the rights granted to you by the EU GDPR at any time:
